

The Ini Rice Terraces are the only terraced paddy fields in Hiroshima Prefecture that have been selected as one of the "100 Most Beautiful Terraced Rice Fields in Japan."

The place was also selected as one of the "Japan's 36 most beautiful places" by CNN. Except for the Itsukushima Shrine, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Ini Tice Terraces were the only one chosen from Hiroshima Prefecture.

The scenery with the vivid contrast between the lush green paddy fields and the stone-piled ridges undulating like a snake makes you feel like you are in an undiscovered paradise that remains today.

Visitors can enjoy the experience of planting rice in spring and harvesting it in fall.

This 200m long wooden bridge over Nishiki-gawa River is known as one of Japan's three most famous bridges. The original bridge was constructed in 1673 in the desire for a flood-resilient bridge, using the best knowledge and skill at the time. It had remained intact for over 270 years until it was washed away by a typhoon in 1950. The bridge was faithfully reconstructed three years later and again in 2001-2004 for conservation purposes. The structure with five high arches built without using nails, is exquisite and original, and the beauty of the bridge has attracted many people including Hokusai, one of the world-famous wood-block print artists.

Cross the bridge and enter Kikko Park, which boasts historic houses that were once home to samurai families.

On this tour, you will not only experience SUP, but also pass under the landmark "Aioi Bridge", which was the target of the atomic bombing back in 1945, and look up at the "Atomic Bomb Dome" from the water. The beautiful cityscape, visible only from the river, will make you realize that Hiroshima is a city where you can feel the importance of peace more than anywhere else in the world.
